13. Title: Extraction of keratin from poultry waste biomass of Himachal Pradesh and its application in the production of value added products

Disposal of feathers from the poultry slaughterhouses industry in India is environmentally unacceptable. The feathers constitute up to 10% of total chicken weight, reaching more than 7.7×10^5 metric ton/year as a by-product of the poultry industry. Chicken feathers have long been thought as a "waste". However, 90% of feathers structure constitutes of keratin, which is an important ingredient in cosmetics. The main objective of this work is the understanding the extraction mechanism of keratin protein from chicken feather using different reducing agents, ionic liquids. Finding suitable techniques for the separation of pure keratin protein and maintaining the functionality and structure of keratin. Currently there is an increasing interest in the development of materials that are environment friendly, obtained from renewable resources. The main renewable materials are obtained from polysaccharides, lipid and proteins. This excessive material is discarded in several cases, being a material of difficult degradation that may become an environmental problem. These hard keratins of chicken feather which are recognized as a solid waste generated from poultry processing industry are insoluble and resistant to degradation by common proteolytic enzymes, such as trypsin, pepsin and papain because of their high degree of cross-linking by disulfide bonds, hydrogen bonding and hydrophobic interactions. Bio-composites based on protein have promising potential applications in the various fields such as in coating industries, in food and nonfood packaging and in biomaterials. Due to excellent sensory properties, high nutritional quality edible films based on protein have excellent potential in food applications and they also have ability to protect food products from their nearby environment. These films have potential to improve the food products quality as they act as a carrier of antioxidant, bacteriostats and flavor. In recent years, these films have gained researchers attention due to their applications in edible and nonedible packaging materials. For the edible films production, the plant and animal proteins like have potential to be used as they possess above

13. Project Summary:

India is an agricultural country wherein about 70% of the population depends on agriculture. Farmers have wide range of diversity to select suitable Fruit and Vegetable crops. However, the cultivation of these crops for optimum yield and quality production can be improved by the aid of technological support. The management of crops requires close monitoring especially for the management of diseases that can affect production significantly and subsequently the post-harvest life. There are several diseases that affect plants with the potential to cause devastating economical, social and ecological losses.

Use of ICT in agriculture is one of the leading areas of research worldwide. Recently, in India numbers of ICT applications for agriculture have proven tremendous growth.


There are several ways to detect plant pathologies. Some diseases do not have any visible symptoms associated, or those appear only when it is too late to act. In this context, diagnosing diseases in an accurate and timely way is of the utmost importance. The existing method for plant disease detection is through naked eye observation by experts which is more laborious task and hiring professional agriculturists may not be affordable especially in remote isolated geographic regions.

Machine vision with Internet of Things (IoT) technologies can offer an alternative solution in plant monitoring; provide image based automatic process control, inspection, and guidance. The prime objective of the proposed scheme is to develop and design a complete solution for assisting farmers in identifying the diseases of commercial crops like tomato, capsicum, cauliflower, brinjal, peas etc in different districts of Himachal Pradesh. This solution will provide feedback to farmers from agriculture scientist/ agriculture experts to find the solution for different categories of diseases and advice on pesticides/sprays to be used for better production.

Our primary focus is on commercial crop diseases, which may be identified from the proposed android based applications using normal smart phones having camera. Images of the diseased crop will be uploaded using the web application and IoT Services and a decision support system will help the farmers in selecting the right pesticides and post diseases steps to be followed. Later on same proposal may be extended for other category of visual diseases for different fruits and vegetables grown in the state of Himachal Pradesh.

Role of PI and Co-PI:

Major Specialization of PI is Image Processing. It helps in image segmentation of various crop diseases using the different algorithms and same may be implemented in MATLAB Software. PI has already published number of research papers in same area and demonstrated her excellence. So, the role of PI is matching with the problem statement.

(b) Addressing priority of the State of H.P.:

Over 93% of the population in Himachal depends directly upon agriculture which provides direct employment to 71% of its people and agriculture contributes over 45% to the net state domestic product. The farm economy of the State assumes a great significance in the context of raising the overall rate of growth of the economy on the one hand, and raising the incomes of the vast multitude of farmers.

Production and marketing of tomato in neighbouring / competing states of Haryana, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan ends up in June. From first week of the July onwards Himachal Pradesh is a sole supplier of tomatoes till second week of October. Further, within the state in the month of July Solan district has advantage over other tomato producing districts of Himachal as it is sole producer at that time. During the months of August and September markets of Punjab, Haryana and Delhi tenninal markets get supplies of peas from these districts and fetch very high price. Capsicum produced in Himachal Pradesh does not face any competition from the other states. The capsicum main producing districts are Kullu, Shimla and Solan. The cabbage produced in Kullu, Lahul-Spiti, Shimla and Solan do not face any competition from other states from April to June

Against this background, the proposed project aims at strengthening extension facilities to educate the farmers about the variations in the normal crop agriculture and they will have exposure to knowledge database along with expert suggestive remedial measures. These support system findings will have outcomes that would affect the livelihood of the local population involved in this crop cultivation.

(c) New Innovativeness expected in the Project:

There are several ways to detect plant pathologies. Some diseases do not have any visible symptoms associated, or those appear only when it is too late to act. In such cases, sophisticated analysis, along with expert advice is necessary. In this approach digital image processing tools will be employed to achieve our goals and IoT technology will be adopted to use the created knowledge database that will benefit the farmers. The proposed decision support system will work in real time scenario not only to detect the disease but also provide the suggestive remedial measures after getting feedback from the farmers.

The novelty of the proposed approach is that it is low cost solution which requires very less human interventions. In addition to this, no specific instrument/device needs to be purchased at the end of farmers. The cost of implementation at the end of farmers will be negligible.

Concerning the hardware, the costs include the high resolution cameras to get the clear pictures, image analysis tools, LED modulators, Wi-Fi modules , and the design of the gateway to transmit data from the nodes to the Base Station. The software development includes analysis, adding security to the communication protocol custom programming in Android at the advances stages. However, proposed model operation expenditures and maintenance cost are meagre.

(g) How appropriately the expected output answers the questions being addressed in the specific subject matter/area?


While a plethora of empirical studies are available in the literature on economic impact of the cultivation of tomato crop, there is no study on suggestive measures by feedback from farmers.

The proposed system would meet the following needs:

- Enhance farmer's perceptions about the health of the crop, nutrient management and the use of sprays/ equipments to enhance the production and quality of the crop.
- Detection of plant disease through automatic technique as it will reduce a large work of monitoring, and at very early stage itself it detects the symptoms of diseases.
- The information about the disease of the crop will be disseminated to the primary user i.e. farmer through the Internet of Things (IoT) technologies in real time, so that precautionary measure can be taken.
- The expert advice and support system with machine vision will provide image based inspection, and guidance.
- By developing Android App and giving access to the farmer a database with IoT technology will help the farmers to have continuous monitoring and evaluation.

(iv) Decision Support System

This module will deal with the provision of suggestive measures and feedback to farmers from agriculture scientist/ agriculture experts to find the solution for different categories of diseases and advice on pesticides/sprays to be used for better production and quality of production. Lastly, testing will be done to improve the quality of results in term of better response time, accuracy of results and other Quality of Service (QoS) parameters.

(v) Algorithm of proposed model

Following algorithm illustrates the step by step approach for the proposed image segmentation and disease recognition processes:

- (1) Image acquisition is the very first step that requires capturing an image with the help of a digital camera.
- (2) Pre-processing of input image to improve the quality of image and to remove the undesired distortion from the image. (Involving clipping of the image is performed to get the interested image region, image smoothing and Image enhancement). Segmentation is done to get clear cut boundaries of the infected areas.
- (3) Analysis of the images in terms of parameters. Create database of all the possible diseases after consulting experts of the field.
- (4) Get real time data from farmers through pic or Android App, compare with the dataset developed of all the diseases pertaining to the crop. Provide suggestive measures after consulting the experts/ researchers/ scientists.

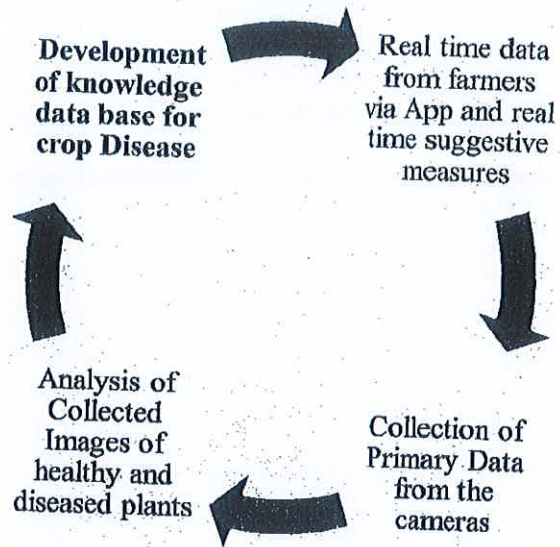


Fig.2 Project Methodology for Early detection of diseased crop

Tentative block diagram for the proposed approach is shown in Fig.1. In addition to this, Project Methodology for Early detection of diseased crop is presented in Fig.2.



Periodic review and inspection of the project will be done by SCSTE team and PI should intimate the Council beforehand about their important milestones activities proposed especially the field activities viz. trainings, site visit etc. in advance. 


