Announcement of significant concessions to wards of Armed Forces, Paramilitary Force personnel and Veer Naaris (war widows)

The VC informed the Council that in order to pay humble tribute to Nation's Soldiers, Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wagnaghat is offering following for the wards of Armed Forces / Paramilitary Forces / War Widows w.e.f Academic Session 2019-20 for a period of five years:-

- a. 10 % seats of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for the Wards of serving Armed and Paramilitary Force Personnel.
- b. 30% concession in B. Tech. Tuition Fees to Wards of Serving Armed Forces and Paramilitary Force Personnel.
- c. 35% concession in B. Tech. Tuition Fees to Wards of Veer Naris (War Widows).
- d. The above is applicable to B. Tech. Programmes only.
- e. The Annual Fee Structure for B. Tech. Programme is as under:-

Programme	Normal Fee	Tuition Fee for Wards of Serving Armed Forces / Paramilitary Force Personnel	Tuition Fee for Wards of Veer Naaris (War Widows)
B. Tech.	Rs.199500/- per annum	Rs.139650/- per annum	Rs.129675/-per annum

Item No. 5/2020-1 Reporting Items:

The following Reporting Items were noted and approved by the Executive Council:-

1. Covid Related Safety Precautions/Measures Undertaken

The chairman informed the members of various measures and safety precautions undertaken at JUIT. Besides the physical measures undertaken the following was also reported:-

- a) Report of Psychological Counselling agency YOUR DOST **Annexure 6**
- b) Compilation of an Administration Reference Book. **Annexure 7.**
- c) Expenses incurred for Covid -19 related procurements. **Annexure 8.**

2. Concessions to students being offered.

The undermentioned concessions being offered to the students/candidates were reported:-

- a) 20 percent reduction in tuition fees for all programs as a Special Covid Relief Package as per the directions of Pro Chancellor for the Academic Year 2020-21.
- b) 30 percent reduction in tuition fees for wards of serving and retired armed forces/Para military forces personnel for candidates admitted in 2019 onwards for a period of 5 years. There are 10 percent seats reserved for such category. An additional 5 percent (total 35%) for wards of Veer Naaris (War Widows). This is as per the decision of the Governing Council Item No 15 held on 20 April 2019.
- c) Five Bhutanese students admitted in 2020 are provided 100 percent freeship on both tuition fees and hostel charges. This is in addition to the 31 Bhutanese students already getting this freeship enrolled in earlier years.

3. Progress on Construction/Repair Works (**Annexure 9**)

Besides the works listed in Annexure 9, the Chairman also informed the status of other ongoing projects as under:-

- a) Extension to Kitchen of Open Cafe: 50 % work is completed.

Sir,

1. A MoU was signed between KIOU Foundation and Jaypee Group for providing 20 Scholarships to Bhutanese students every year commencing from July 2005 for a period of 10 years i.e. upto end of year 2015 (copy enclosed).
2. No new MoU has been signed thereafter.
3. After the expiry of this MoU, students of Bhutan were admitted by taking your kind approval till last year i.e. upto academic year 2020-21.
4. As per the old MoU, Tuition Fee and Lodging was to be paid by the Jaypee Group and Food, Travelling Allowance and Out of Pocket expenses was to be paid by the Foundation.
5. For the last 4 years, as per your kind approval, Bhutanese students were also provided free food by the University.
6. This year again, we have received 5 applications of Bhutanese students for admissions at JUIT, Wagnaghat (copies of their CVs enclosed). They are processing the cases of 5 more candidates which they will send at a later date.
7. We have requested the Foundation to inform the candidates that they have to meet their boarding and lodging expenses by themselves. But we have not received any reply from the Foundation so far.

Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU)

This MOU has been drawn up between the Youth Development Fund (YDF), Bhutan and JAYPEE Group, India, in Delhi, on 9th February, 2005 for the programme titled Human Resource Development Assistance (HRDA). This MOU shall remain valid for a period of 10 academic years until the end of year 2015. The terms and conditions of the MOU are outlined below:

Introduction/Premise/Preamble

Working toward establishing a long term association between the people of Bhutan and JAYPEE Group, India;

Having the desire to contribute to strengthening the growing economy of Bhutan;

Recognizing the importance of human resource development in the all round economic development of Bhutan;

Acknowledging the valuable educational opportunities at the IT Universities and IT Institutes of the 'Jaiprakash Sewa Sansthan', a NOT FOR PROFIT Trust in India, which focus on the objectives of Education, Enlightenment and Empowerment;

Realizing the need for educational places to meet the growing population of educated Bhutanese youth;

Noting the importance of IT and technical training in accessing employment opportunities both within Bhutan and abroad.

PROVISIONS

1. JAYPEE Group will provide 20 scholarships every year commencing from July 2005 to the YDF. Details are as follows:


3. JAYPEE Group will reserve the seats for Bhutanese students for every academic year commencing from July 2005.

4. YDF will institute a mechanism for selection of appropriate candidates which will be entirely merit based for pre-service candidates and need based for in-service candidates. Mechanism of selection shall be finalized by YDF in consultation with Educational Authority of JAYPEE Group.

5. The age limit of the beneficiaries shall not exceed 22 years for Graduate level education and 18 years for III.



8. The provisions of this MOU may be amended as and when necessary with the consent of both the parties involved, i.e. JAYPEE Group and YDF.



Whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
8. The University will keep the whole of the grant in an interest bearing Bank Account, and the interest so earned should be reported to DBT in the Utilization Certificate and Statement of Expenditure. The interest so earned shall be remitted to Consolidated Fund of India, i.e., Bharatkosh.
9. The domestic travel by Air- India in refundable economy class is admissible under travel expenses as per GOI norms. There will be no international travel undertaken from the grant release under the project.

WILLIAM WEBSTER MERIT-CUM-MEANS SCHOLARSHIP **(Academic Year 2021-22)**

BRIEF ON SCHOLARSHIP

Jaiprakash Sewa Sansthan has setup an initial corpus for the William Webster Merit-Cum-Means Scholarship to be provided to eligible students from income earned by way of interest from the corpus. The scholarship is being provided to students admitted to Jaypee Education System across the four campuses from the Academic Year 2004 onwards through a transparent mechanism by as scholarship committee setup up for the purpose.

Selected students for this scholarship get a tuition fee waiver for one semester in an academic year, applicable for the batch of entry of awardees. All scholarship amounts will be adjusted against the tuition fees of the year in which approved.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR AWARD (FRESH CASES)

- Combined income of parents/guardian should be less than or equal to Rs. 1.5 Lacs per annum.
- Merit is determined on the basis of following weightages of marks obtained in classes 10th, 12th and performance in B.Tech. 1st semester.
Class 10th: 15%, Class 12th: 35%, B.Tech. 1st sem.: 50%

The income certificate issued by the Competent Authority (Minimum, Executive Magistrate or Tehsildar) should be enclosed along with the application form. Income Tax returns shall not be accepted as proof of Income.

Applications are to be invited from B.Tech. 1st year students admitted in the Academic Session 2021-22 at JUIT, Wagnaghat on the prescribed form proposed to be sent to students by email.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA (CONTINUATION CASES)

A student shall continue to get the scholarship, in the subsequent years provided he/she fulfils the following criteria:

- Minimum CGPA of 7.0 on 10 point scale.
 - Combined income of parents/guardian should be less than or equal to Rs. 1.5 Lacs per annum.
- All recipients in past should fill up the fresh application & attach fresh income certificate of parents.**

The last date for submitting the application form (fresh/continuation cases) is 03.03.2022. The form and supporting documents must be sent by email to arindam.das@juitsolan.in

The decision of the Scholarship Committee is undisputable and binding on all.

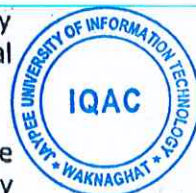

3. Employees eligibility to avail the benefit of the above financial support/ assistance will be governed by the following: -

(a) Employees who have completed minimum 5 years of continuous service with the Company or Group of Companies on the date of admission of the child in the Group's Educational Institutions.

(b) Financial support shall be extended to the employees based on merit of student at the entry stage to the educational institutions (admission to IIIT / JUIT / JIET / ITIs / JVM is by merit only) and shall be continued only on good academic performance in every semester / year i.e. at least 60% as well as on good behaviour in which at least 75 out of 100 marks is the minimum requirement.

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Those who do not fulfill these two criteria, will not be eligible for the continuation of financial support from the next semester / year. Discontinuation of support / assistance due to academic performance or behaviour may be further reviewed in case employee's children improves academic performance and behaviour in next semesters / year. However, in such cases, management reserves the right of restoration of support / assistance.

- (c) The employee should have amount equivalent to loan in their gratuity account. Otherwise, they would sign a suitable loan agreement with the company.
- (d) Loan recovery shall start only after the Student completes the course. This will also apply to cases where support / assistance is discontinued due to academic performance or due to discipline.
- (e) In case of separation of the employees on any account either side, the grant and waiver would cease off with effect from the date of separation. All out standing loan in this respect would be recovered while settling the full & final account of the employee.
- (f) In case of promotion to the employee on higher grades, admissibility of grant / waiver / support would be guided as applicable in promoted grade. In case of promotion to the grade where this scheme is not applicable, the employees will continue availing this assistance as applicable to him before promotion.
- (g) Since employees may have their posting in different location in group of companies, institutions concerned may not be aware about the separation of the employee. Thus, at the end of semester / year institution would take approval for continuation of assistance from Head Office. It is essential that Unit Incharge, from whose unit, the employees avail loan first time, may introduce suitable clause in relieving letter/transfer order indicating availment of this facility, for good records
- (h) Employees who are already availing this facility, would also form part of this Office Order. They will be now governed by new guidelines
- (i) Eligible employees who are interested in utilizing financial support for their wards may be requested to submit application to the site In-charge / HOD to Joint President (HQ) for centralized processing to the respective institutions. Site In-charge / HOD may forward the application along with the details of the employee as per the format as appended below;
