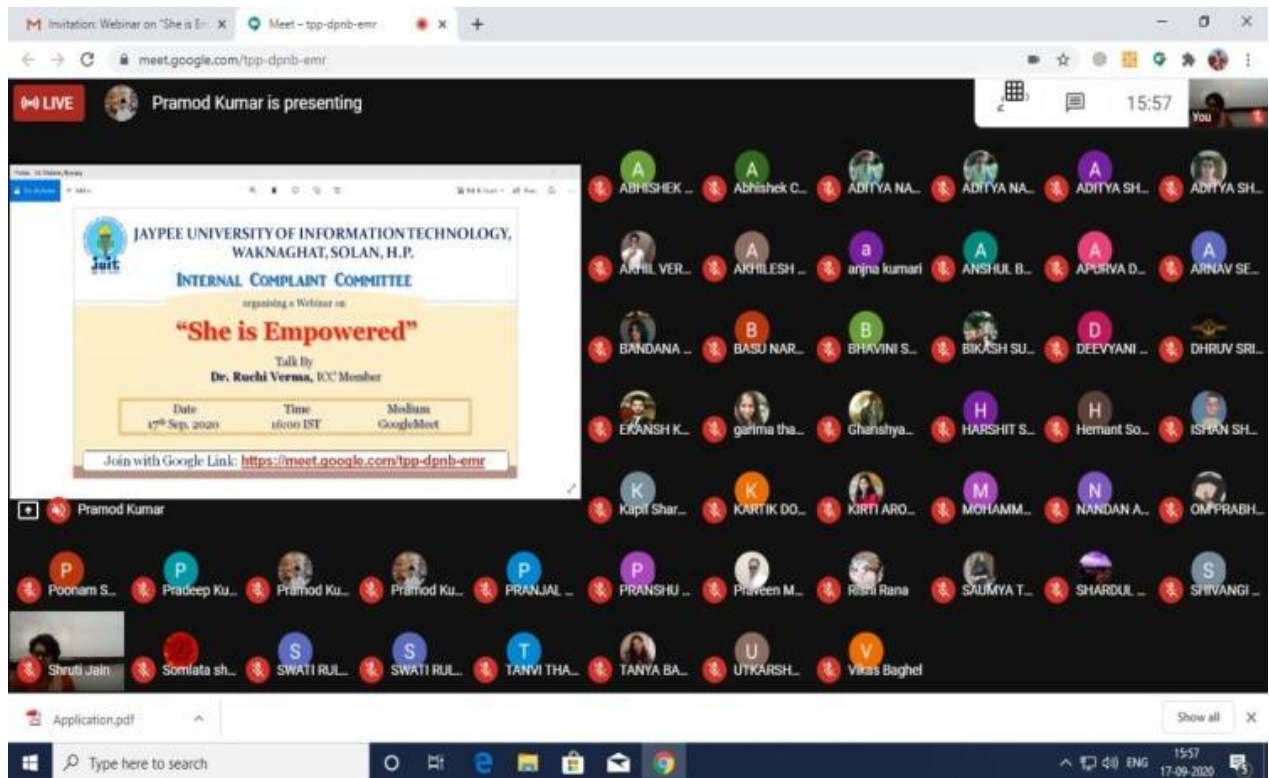

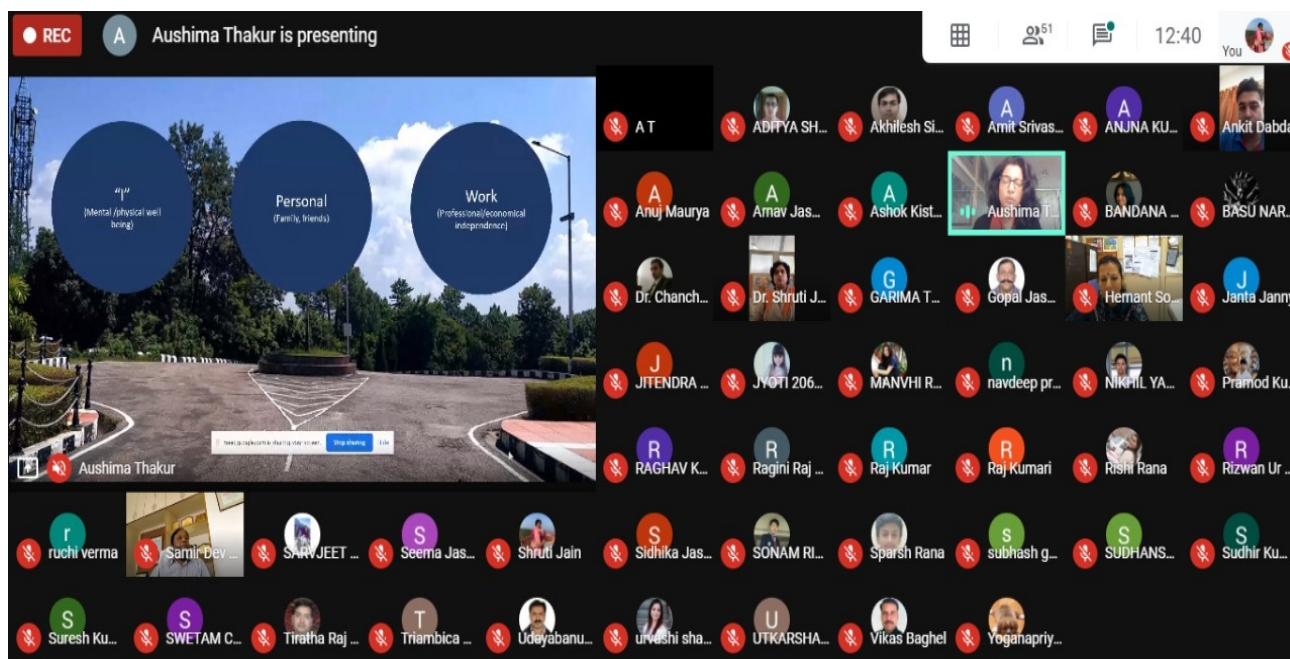

Report of Webinar “Women Empowerment”

on October 17, 2020 by Caste Based Discrimination Committee



The webinar titled “*Women Empowerment*” was organized by the Caste Based Discrimination Committee, JUIT Waknaghat. The event was started at 12:30P.M with a welcome speech by Dr.Ruchi Verma, faculty member of the committee. She extended her warm welcome to the speaker of the session **Dr. Aushima Thakur**, Director HR (Philips, Netherlands), Honorable Director **Prof. Samir Dev Gupta**, Director and Academics Head, JUIT, faculties and participants of the event. About 60-65 participants attended the event.

Aushima Thakur is Director HR at Philips in Netherlands. She is originally from Himachal Pradesh. Her graduation is in Life Sciences from HPU, a Masters degree in English Literature from Panjab University, and Doctorate degree in Socio-linguistics from Panjab University and an MBA from Erasmus University, Netherlands.

She started her career as a teaching faculty in Govt. College Hamirpur (on an adhoc basis) and then shifted to corporate. She was in the People Operations team (HR) in Google India (both Hyderabad and Gurgaon). She left Google to teach at University of Iowa US, on a Fulbright scholarship. She moved to Netherlands for her MBA, and now has been working in the Netherlands for the last 9 years. She started her post-MBA career with Philips Lighting, moved to an insurance-Investment Management company, and is now back at Philips healthtech at their corporate HQ in Amsterdam.

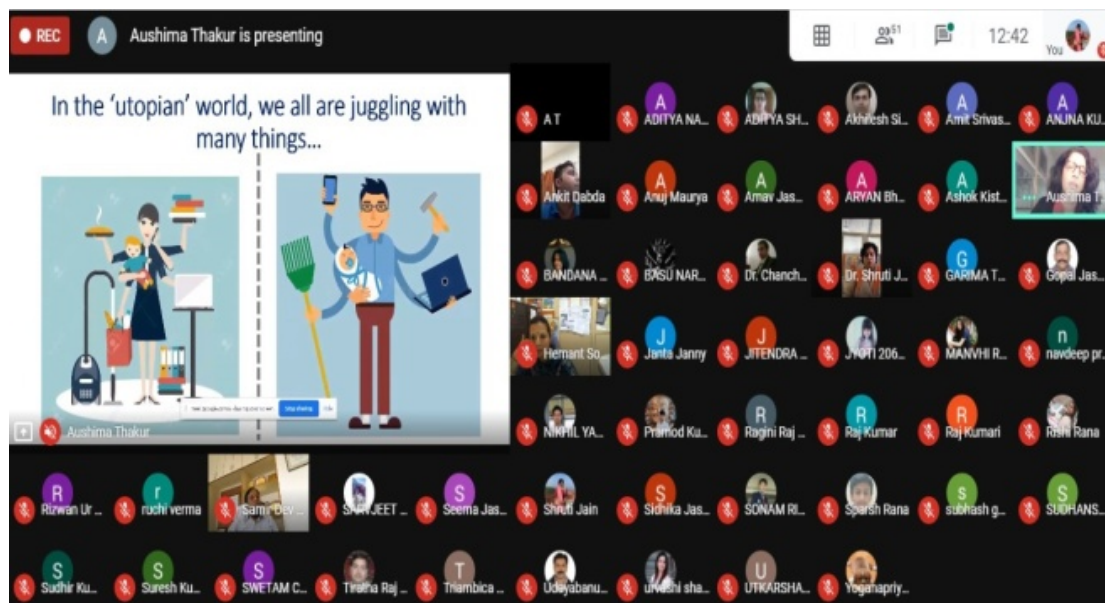

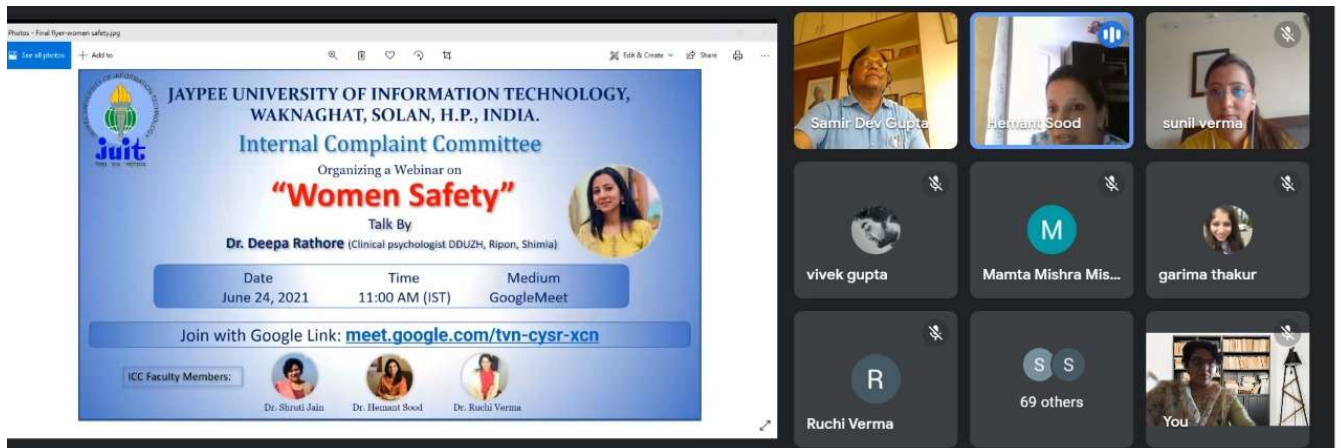

Report of Webinar “Women Safety”



The Internal Complaints Committee, JUIT Wagnaghat organized a webinar on the topic '**Women Safety**' on 24th June 2021 from 11.00 am to 12.00 pm on the Google Meet platform. The event was attended by over 95 participants including faculty, research scholars, and students from different universities across India. Dr. Hemant Sood, the faculty member of ICC, commenced the webinar by extending her warm welcome to the speaker of the session **Dr. Deepa Rathore** (Clinical Psychologist DDU ZH, Ripon, Shimla), Honorable Director Prof. Samir Dev Gupta, Dean of Academic, JUIT, faculties, and participants of the event.

Dr. Deepa Rathore who has been working as a clinical psychologist in DDUZH, Shimla since October 2013 is an alumnus of St. Luke, Solan, holds a Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Psychology and a Doctorate in Psychology from HPU. She also has a one-year of counseling experience as a school psychologist in KVS Chandigarh.

She initiated the discourse by emphasizing how physical and emotional abuse of women has been a major human rights issue for several years amongst all socio-economic groups. She highlighted that with the outbreak of Covid-19 there have been unprecedented obstacles for women such that an increase of 21% in domestic violence was reported. While discussing about the problems relating to working women she encouraged the audience to contribute towards women empowerment for the welfare of the community. Dr. Deepa also stated her faith on the

next generation who will resist the inequalities we observe every day and internalize these ideals in our work.

Violence against Women

- Over the years, whether it was the Rameeza Bee rape case(1978), Manorama in Manipur(2004), the Nirbhaya case in Delhi(2012) or now in Hathras, these sexual offenses against women exposed the reality of structural violence.
- It must be noted that in India, there are a range of intersections like identity, social structures and customs and traditions that lead to such systematic violence.

holding certificates. The event had 57 participants and feedback form has been collected in the form of google form ,for the further improvements. The event was a great success and exposure as mentioned by participants .



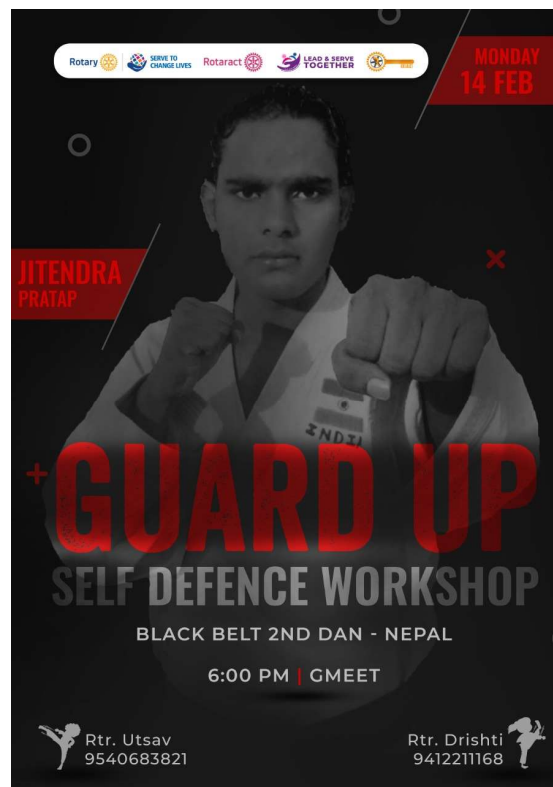

STUDENTS LEARN SELF DEFENCE AT 'GUARD UP'



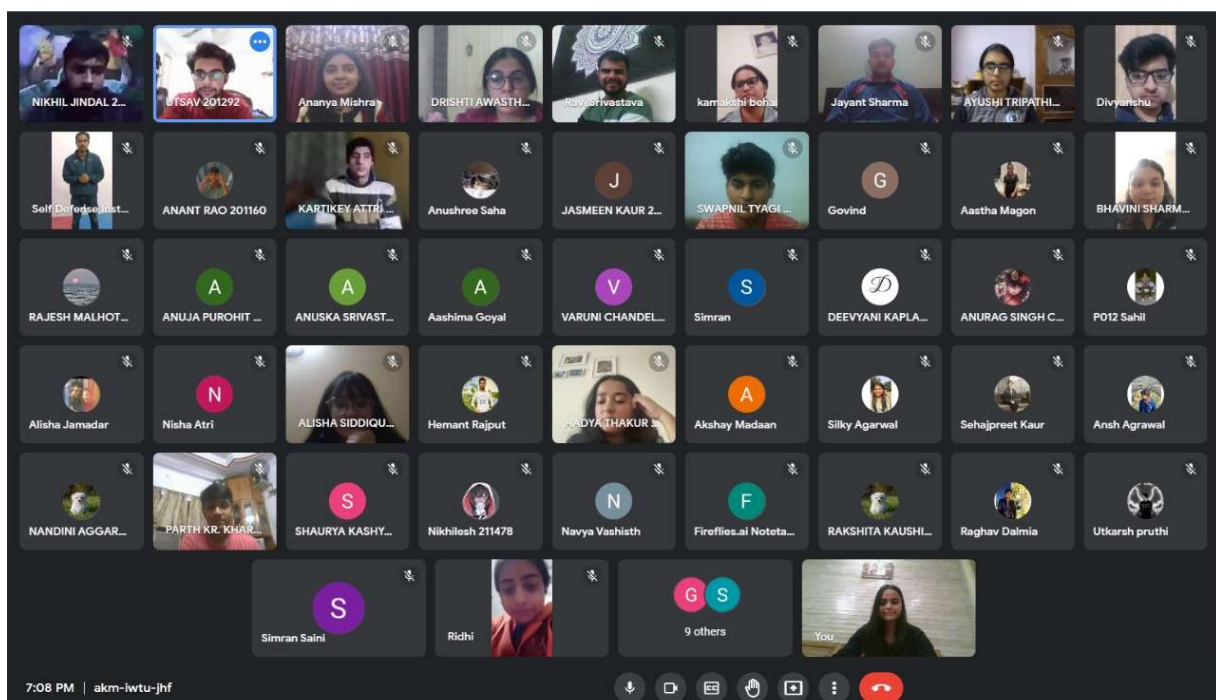

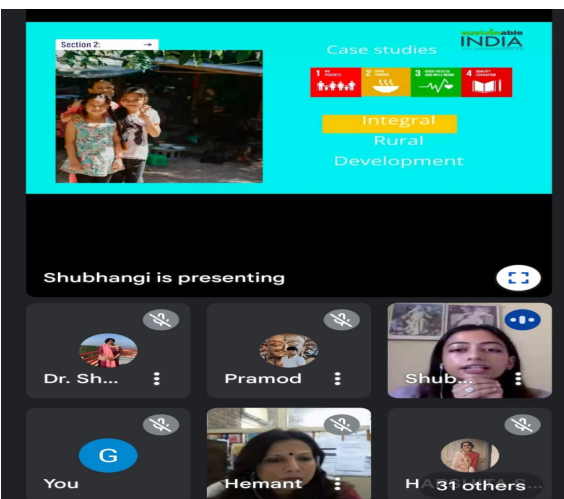
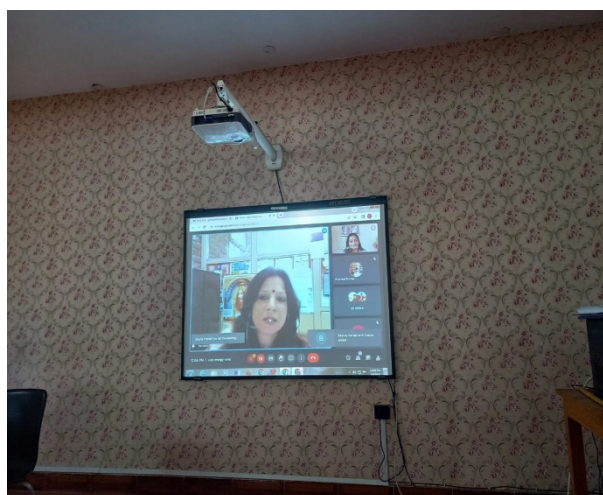


Report on Slogan Writing Contest

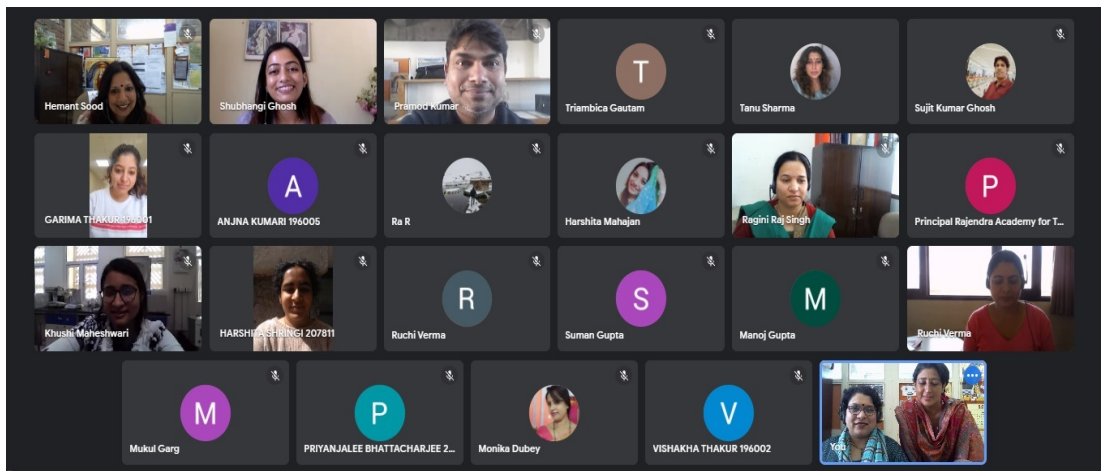
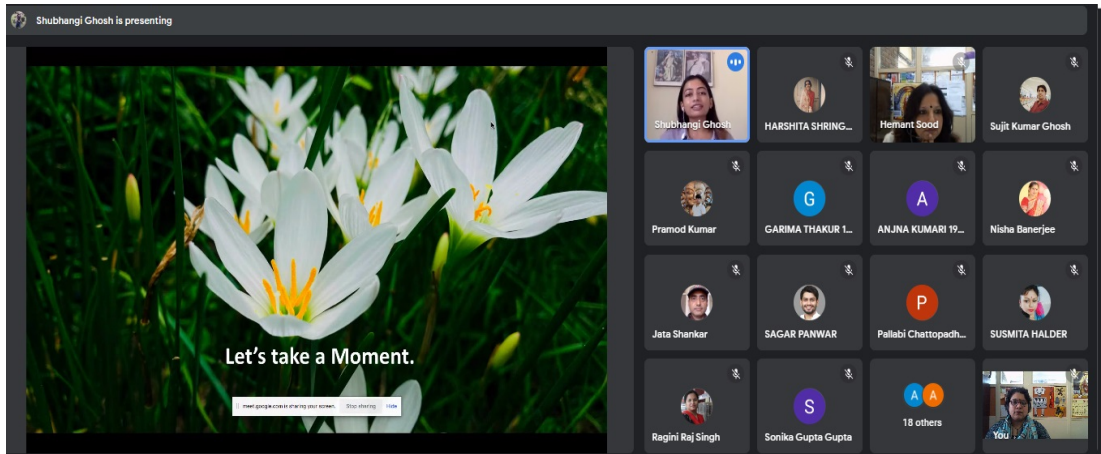
