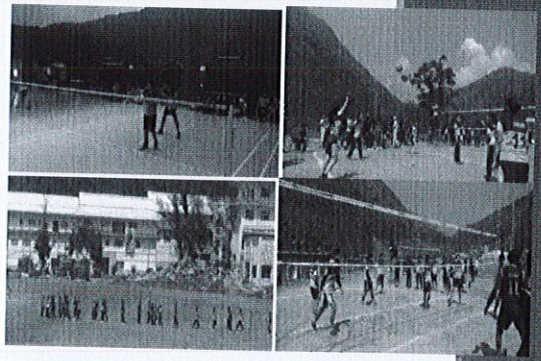
SPORTS MANIA

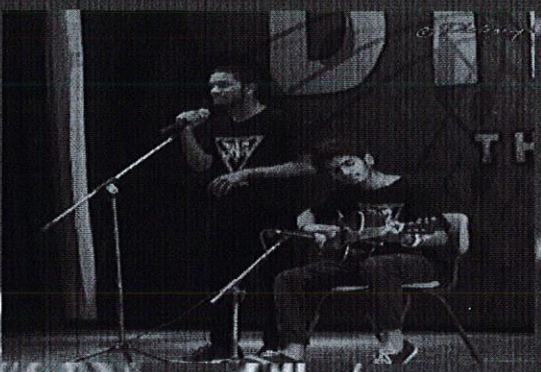
Freshers' Party (13 August 2017)

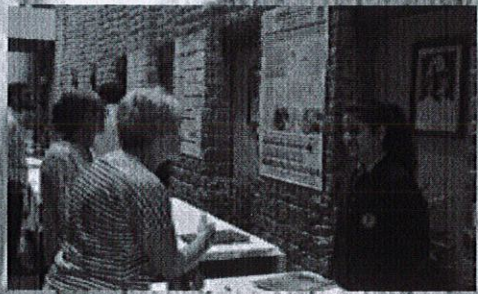
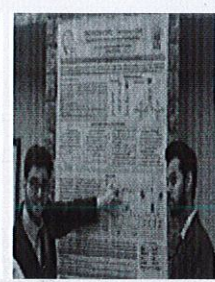
POSTER PRESENTATION COMPETITION

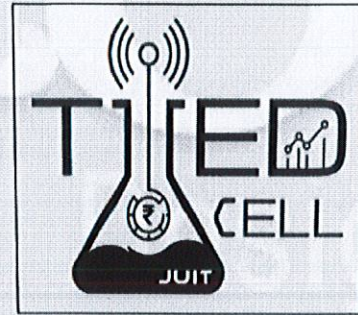

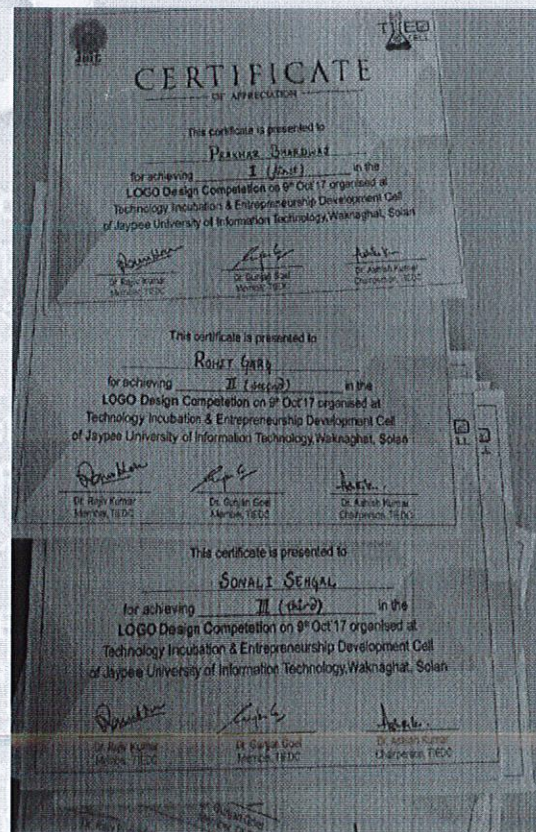
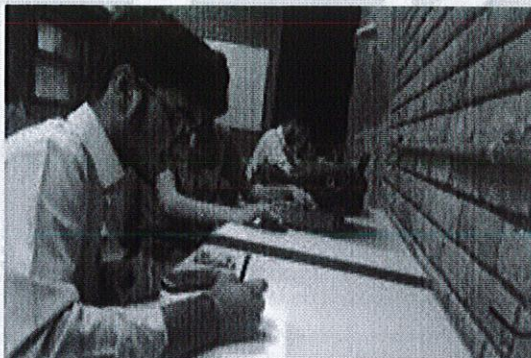
LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION

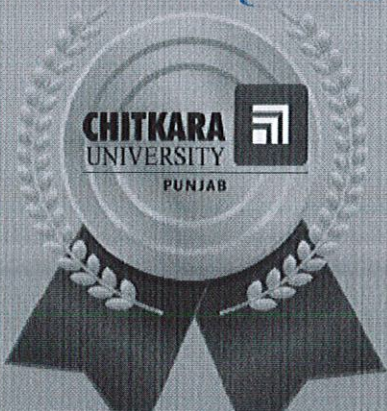

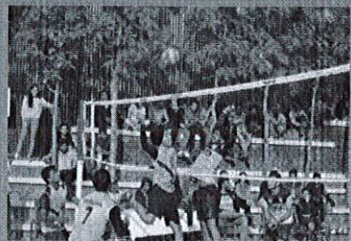

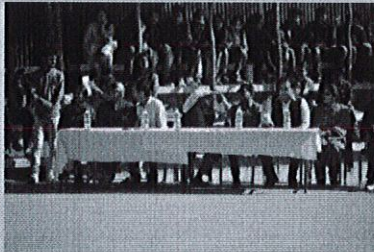
HALLA BOL

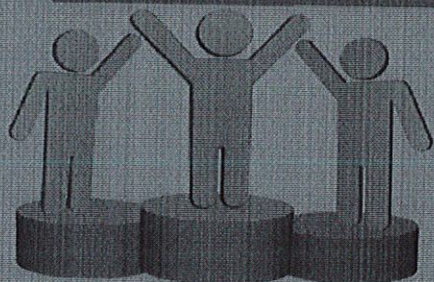
