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Student Council Organization Structure


JUIT Youth Club

Focusing on technical, literary, sports, and cultural scopes, these competitive activities, apart from serving as a relief from intense academic load, present an opportunity to instill confidence, encourage teamwork and give students a strong sense of achievement and belonging.

Its Office bearers are selected in a competitive manner and include President, Secretary, and Treasurer . Following procedure is followed for a student to become the member of JYC:

- 1. For holistic development of students, they can join maximum of 2 clubs and 1 committee.
- 2. Interested students are required to fill a form on the basis of which a brief interview is conducted.
- 3. Students in the 1st and 2nd year of their academic programmes can be general body members.
- 4. Students of third and fourth year work as coordinators for successful completion of events-GISTRAR.

5. Since JYC is a student's body, therefore, it runs primarily with the small contribution of from the students. However, sometimes, depending on the requirements, JUIT also support it financially.


The various Clubs of JYC are in alignment with the NEP 2020 and presently these are as under:-

Introduction

- To create suitable regulatory mechanism for effective delivery of services to Disabled Students and Staff of the University and research centers.
- To ensure implementation of all legislations with respect to persons with disabilities.

- To provide accessible and inclusive education to differently-abled persons in the University.
- To ensure full participation of persons with disabilities and to provide them equal opportunities for development.

Policy Statement:

University will facilitate higher education for differently abled persons (PwDs) in every stream and would have necessary aids and appliances for higher education of PwDs.

Qualified Persons with Disability:

The term "qualified persons with disability" refers to an individual with a disability who is qualified to participate in any given University program or activity.

- With respect to enrolment, a qualified person with disability must satisfy
 the academic standards required for admission and meet the academic
 requirements established for any given course, degree, or certificate
 program.
- With respect to employment, training, work assignments, and promotion, a qualified individual with a disability must be able to perform the minimum essential functions of the job.
- 3. . Moreover relaxation shall be allowed as per the Government rules.

Governing Bodies:

JUIT will constitute an expert committee which will be responsible in formulating, implementing and revising policy and guidelines for persons with disabilities.

The Committee shall consist of minimum five members selected from faculty from the University, experts in the field and persons with disabilities. All committee members shall be appointed by Vice Chancellor of the University for

period of three years. The committee should meet at least twice a year to review the concerned activities.

The Major Functions of Expert Committee for Persons with Disabilities Include:

 To address all disability related issues in the University and Research Centers.

 To ensure overall accessibility for persons with disabilities in the entire University system including departments and researches centers.

 To guide activities of the enabling units or resource centre by providing expert suggestions.

4. To resolve major grievances pertaining to any matter of persons with disabilities. The matter shall be first referred to HODs. If it is not resolved, it should be sent to the competent authorities.

She can directly approach to any member of ICC to report the incidence of such harassment later followed by a written complaint addressed to the Presiding Officer, ICC. The ICC is required to complete the proceedings of inquiry in the matter and submit its fact finding report within 90 days of the filing of the complaint positively. All such complaints will be kept confidential. The formal written complaint must mandatorily contain:

- · Date and time of the incident
- · The place where it occurred
- · Name and contact information of the accused
- · Name and contact information of witnesses
- · Detailed description of the incident

Committee members are directed to take up the assigned responsibility seriously and if required detailed guidelines available at the website may be referred. This is for information of all concerned.






'MasterChef 2019' not only provided a platform for the students to foster their creativity and culinary skills but also allowed them to interact with teachers outside academic setup.
