
#### **HEALTH CLUB**


## Freshers' Party (13 August 2017)




## POSTER PRESENTATION COMPETI


## LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION






One week lecture series by ISKCON


### PARAKARAM - 2017







The event winners were awarded with prizes and certificates. Students' coordinators and volunteers were awarded with appreciation certificates. Murious XII was a huge success.




## **REPUBLIC DAY**
