

## FINAL REPORT - INDUCTION ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

### General:-

As per the directives of the UGC implemented through AICTE, the JUIT conducted a two weeks induction orientation programme for First Year Batch w.e.f. 19 July 2019 to 03 August 2019. The aim of this programme was to enable students fresh from school life to settle down into University life. Towards this end the structure of the programme primarily focussed on motivational talks, physical activities and campus awareness activities.

### Composition:-

### Broad Format:-

All physical activities such as sports, yoga, nature walks, campus awareness walks, were conducted early morning from 6:30 a.m to 7:30 a.m. Almost every day one guest speaker/in-house faculty/staff conducted lecture-cum presentation before and/or after lunch. The balance time was utilised for visit to departmental labs, visit to library, NAD and Biometric registration, completion of documentation etc. The detailed two weeks time table of the Induction Programme for all the six groups is attached as Appendix A. Amplification Notes of these are enclosed as Annexure-I to Appendix A. Following activities were added in this years Induction Programme:-

### Attendance:

Though the Induction Programme is not counted towards academic attendance, it was impressed upon the students that attendance for this programme would be seen as a positive indicator towards the student. Attendance was taken during both forenoon and afternoon. The attendance record is kept in records. Students with attendance 80% and above of all groups is at Appendix B.

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In order to ensure that all students participating in the Induction Programme attend the scheduled activities, it was ensured that atleast one of the faculty coordinators is accompanying the group for the activity. Even activities outside the campus such as visit to Indian Institute of Advanced Studies in Shimla, trek to Tara Devi and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan activities had a sizeable involvement of both faculty and non teaching staff.

**Feedback:-**

On termination of the Induction Programme, a feedback of all talks-cum-presentations and the various activities conducted was taken from each student. These were compiled by each group coordinator which enabled a summarised feedback to be worked out. The same is enclosed as follows:-

**ATTENDANCE-INDUCTION PROGRAM FOR FRESH BATCH**

1. The experience of last two Induction Programs conducted for the Fresh B.Tech Batch shows that students' attendance for various events as per Induction Program Time Table has been declining. This is primarily due to the fact that both students and their parents are aware that the Induction Program is not mandatory, as its attendance/absence holds no relevance presently.
2. Since the Induction Program is a UGC mandated activity, the aims and objectives can only be achieved if a fresher attends the Program whole heartedly. Campus awareness, adjusting to new environment, getting acquainted with faculty and university routine are major benefits of this program. The fresher seamlessly integrates with the Academic and Administrative environment and is able to start academics in the right earnest after the Induction Program.
3. The following is proposed for Academic Year 2020-21:-
  - a) 80% attendance of Induction Program should be mandatory. This would also be an inspection point for Central Regulatory Bodies, since it is a UGC mandated requirement.
  - b) Attendance of Induction Program should be linked to regular academic attendance to the extent that any student who does not meet the mandatory Academic Attendance of 80% in a semester will be considered for relaxation of upto 5 percent i.e. upto 75% attendance provided he/she has 80% attendance in the Induction Program.
  - c) Appearing in Induction Program Test should be mandatory and its marks should be sent to parents of student on their email for their information.
  - d) A certificate of successful completion of Induction Program should be issued to each student who has 80% Attendance in Induction Program and passes the Quiz Test.

I am looking forward to visiting your University. You may kindly consider organizing lectures/training programmes on the following topics:





## FINAL REPORT – INDUCTION ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

### General

As per the directives of UGC implemented through AICTE, the JUIT conducted a two weeks induction orientation programme for First Year Batch w.e.f. 23 August 2022 to 05 September 2022. The aim of this programme was to enable student fresh from school life to settle down into University life. ### Broad Format



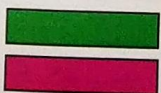
