The team imparted their knowledge about different kinds of biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste and its segregation before dumping. They found that the villagers had some common problems such as the non-availability of cleaners in the village and the long distances that they had to travel for dumping waste. The villagers usually burnt the waste produced in their household for which the UBA team discussed the alternate ways to tackle that problem. Apart from that the team also discussed the medical facilities and their availability in the village. They found that villagers had to travel to nearby villages for basic medical facilities. After observing and noting down all the problems the survey ended at 12:00 PM. In the end, it was a very successful and memorable event.
