In order to promote gender equality, guaranteed by Article 15 of the Indian Constitution, we need to change the mode of interaction at all levels - home, school, and workplace and so on. To increase the outreach for creating an environment that fosters equal treatment, Government of India envisages engagement of **Gender Champions** in all schools and colleges across the country. **Gender Champions can be any student above 16 years of age enrolled in educational institutions.** It is a joint initiative of the Ministry of women and Child Development and Ministry of Human Resource Development.
