Student-Centric Approach: The importance of personalized and inclusive learning, ensuring no child is left behind. Empowering students to shape their academic and career paths.

The interactive session fostered a dynamic environment where students posed questions about the implementation of NEP 2020 and its relevance to their educational journey. Key





concerns included the adaptability of existing institutions to the proposed changes and the role of students in embracing this transformative shift.



The speaker addressed these queries with practical examples, ensuring clarity and inspiring students to actively participate in the evolving education landscape. The event underscored the importance of NEP 2020 in shaping the future of education and empowering students to achieve their aspirations.
