Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) and Technology Incubation & Entrepreneurship Development Cell, Jaypee University of Information Technology, Waknaghat (H.P.) organised "Storage Wars-Innovation ThinkBox" on 9th March, 2024 at Basketball Court (BBC), JUIT campus. More than 74 participants, participated in the event.

Event Objective: Uncover hidden treasures and mysteries within mysterious boxes through strategic bidding and intuition, sparks interest in entrepreneurship, participants engage in a thrilling auction where the contents remain unknown until claimed. Keeping in mind the importance of the same, IIC in collaboration with TIEDC organized an event "Storage wars" to develop a broad understanding as well as to generate curiosity among students related to finance and technology by integrating technical terms found within the mysterious boxes into unique pitch ideas, fostering a platform for students to develop compelling presentations that showcase their ingenuity and problem-solving skills.

Event Description: The event was a thrilling event where students had been given a set amount of money to spend. However, they had to be incredibly careful about how they spent it. Why? Because they were

heading to a unique auction where they would bid on mystery boxes. These boxes were filled with all sorts of surprises, but the students wouldn't know what was inside until they won the bid. So, they had to be strategic with their money, ensuring they had enough to bid on the boxes they truly desired. This event merged finance and technology, prompting strategic bidding on mystery boxes. Technical terms within the boxes inspired unique pitch ideas, fostering problem-solving skills and ingenuity. The event aimed to cultivate curiosity and understanding among students through engaging presentations. During the event, participants were supposed to create PowerPoint presentations and innovate a product based on any technical domain topic they found in the box. This aspect added an exciting dimension to the competition, requiring participants to not only bid strategically but also to analyse and innovate based on the contents of their acquired boxes. It encouraged students to think critically about how they could leverage their technical knowledge to develop compelling products or solutions. At the end of the event, winners were declared based on who had made the most profit. This profit was calculated by subtracting the approximate value of the items seen in the box from the amount spent to win the bid. Therefore, it wasn't just about luck – it was about making smart decisions and maximizing earnings through strategic bidding and innovative thinking.

Event's Benefits: After the completion of the event, the attendees got to know about a lot of things related to finance, money management and learned new ways to pitch them along with their importance. The workshop covered:
