Technovatorz Electronics Club of JUIT organized CIRCUITHOURS on 9th August 2018, Thursday. This event was conducted solely for first year students (all branches) to introduce them to the world of circuitry.

The event started at 5:30 p.m. with inspiring words of the teacher coordinators Mr. Mohit Garg and Dr. Nishant Jain, briefing the students with the club and event.

Basics of electronics devices (resistors, transistors, capacitors, multi-meter, CRO and DSO) and circuit implementation were taught with great eagerness by the student coordinators to the first year students. The students were firstly demonstrated and then were made to implement the circuits on their own. Four fourth year coordinators and seven third coordinators along with faculty coordinators and lab engineer Mr. Abhishek were present to assess the participants.

By 7:30 pm the students were well aware about the circuits and different components in the laboratory and were able to implement the circuits on breadboard.

Then we went on to the second level of the event, the Quiz. Students were given a printed question sheets with 10 questions. Assessment was done on the basis of what they learnt from the session. 20 minutes of time was given and after 20 minutes, 11 students were shortlisted for the next round.

The next round was the Circuit implementation round in which the students were given a circuit and they had to implement in 15 minutes. After a strong completion the finalist (Diwakar Srivastava) and the runner up (Akhil Makkar) were decided and were awarded by Mr. Mohit Garg and Dr. Nishant Jain. All the participants were given the certificates of participation.

The event concluded with vote of thanks of teacher coordinators and student coordinators.
