**IMPORTANT COMMUNIQUE FOR PARENTS/STUDENTS**

1. As July approaches, queries from some of you have been raised through various forums on University Reopening.
2. This communiqué is to keep you updated on some Administrative issues:-
  - a) The JUIT's opening will be guided by Government's/UGC directives on opening of Universities.
  - b) Certain measures which have been planned for adoption at JUIT Campus are as follows:-
    - i) Out of the 4 batches Regd., only two are planned to be called at any given time to campus. This shall result in 50 percent reduction enabling single room occupancy for all.
    - ii) As regards Final Year Students, a centralised effort for obtaining dues if any is being carried out so that 'No Dues' is not a movement and time intensive activity for students.
    - iii) All students are advised to mention their specific query (if any) for which a case to case basis solution shall be found. This may be Academic or Administrative.
    - iv) All safety precautions spelt out by Government and Medical authorities are being put in place/already in place e.g.
      - aa) Washbasins with Soap dispensers at multiple locations from Main Gate upto CE Department.
      - ab) Sanitization Chambers for baggage/individual Sanitization.
      - ac) Paint/Sticker markings for social distancing.
      - ad) Seating in Academic Block is reduced to 50 percent by marking X on seats not to be occupied/seats removed.
      - ae) Computer Labs – Only alternative computers to be functional.
      - af) The 50 percent students in campus will be further segregated in two batches on arrival Staggered Meal Timings for the two batches will ensure that only 25% strength is in Annapurna at any given time. Within Annapurna only 4 students can sit on a big table and 2 on smaller table thus meeting social distancing norms adequately.
      - ag) Seats not to be utilised are marked cross or removed.

- ah) A Sanitization Spray after dining by one batch will be carried out before next batch can move for dining.
  - ai) Food at Counter will be served by Mess Helper who is with protective gloves and mask etc. Students shall not handle the serving spoons themselves.
  - aj) Dhabas and move out of campus is banned . Hygiene and sanitization standards of these locations are not within JUIT's jurisdiction. YOU HAVE TO COOPERATE and not be a part of problem in this regard.
  - ak) Complete Academic Block including Classrooms etc have been washed. Hostels are already sanitized due to non-occupancy. However periodic cleaning of Washrooms and Common areas has been in progress during lockdown also.
  - al) All students will be in single room and are advised not to visit other rooms/common places.
  - am) Do not loiter on campus without reason. Avoid till situation improves.
  - an) Students playing Basketball, Volleyball, using gym etc will be allowed strictly under sports coach supervision.
  - ao) Lift in Academic Block has been made dysfunctional to avoid multiple touches by various persons. Use Stairs.
  - ap) Remember we are equally concerned about you as your parents are. While we will do our best, we definitely need your cooperation.
3. Last but not least is to caution everyone that anyone not cooperating and found endangering own self/others will be politely asked to move out of the campus.
4. The Final Year Students coming to collect their baggage may do so between now and 12 July 2020. However, it is essential that you intimate your 'ETA/Travel history to Registrar at [registrar@juit.ac.in](mailto:registrar@juit.ac.in). Any specific problem by individual student will be handled on case to case basis.
5. Since rooms of final year students are to be sanitized and offered to 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> year it is essential that rooms are vacated by 12 July 2020 positively.
