NOTIFICATION

SRI BADRIKA ASHRAM EMERGING YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

Sri Badrika Ashram Emerging Youth Scholarship has been introduced for the students to be admitted in the Academic Session 2022-23 onwards. The eligibility criteria and other conditions for availing scholarship is notified as under:-

Eligibility Criteria:-

1. Candidate must be a Himachal Pradesh resident holding a Himachal domicile.
2. Candidate must have enrolled as a full time student in undergraduate degree / diploma in the University.
3. Meritorious student who have scored at least 60% (for BPL category) and 75% (for other categories) and above in 12th standard.
4. Candidate must bear good conduct / character.

Scholarship Amount:-

Amount equal to Tuition Fee amount (may vary from 50% to 100%) subject to maximum of Rs. 2.5 lacs per student per annum.

Initial Selection Criteria:- The order of priority for selection of the candidate for award of scholarship shall be as under:-

- I. Students from below poverty line (BPL) families (BPL card is required) with minimum of 60% marks in 12th standard.
- II. Students other than BPL category having family annual income below Rs. 3.00 lacs (income proof such as certificate from Tehsildar/SDM is required) with minimum of 75% marks in 12th standard.
- III. The order of priority for selection of the candidate falling in category II shall be as under:-
 - i) Orphaned students.
 - ii) Single parent households – mother or father are separated / expired.
 - iii) Families with cases of chronic / terminal illness in the family such as cancer, etc.
 - iv) Background of parents such as those who are engaged in manual jobs, i.e. daily wage labourers, ex-servicemen from the Indian Armed Forces.
 - v) Families with multiple daughters.
 - vi) Meritorious students attained more than 90% marks in 12th standard.

Continuation Criteria:- The continuation of above scholarship from 2nd year onwards is subject to meeting the following criteria:-

1. Candidate should have maintained 75% or above attendance during the preceding semester of years.
2. 60% of above marks in previous semester / year.
3. Student not availing any other scholarship from other private or government organization.
4. Undertaking that student bears good conduct and behaviour.

Other Conditions:-

1. Students shall be considered for the scholarship on first cum first serve basis.
2. The Society offering scholarship is having complete autonomy in deciding the awardee based on its internal selection criterion.
3. Students taking admission under management quota are not eligible for the scholarship scheme.
4. No limit for selection of awardees. Open to maximum eligible students meeting internal selection process.
5. Scholarship is non-transferable at the behest of student / University.
6. Scholarship offering Society reserves the right to terminate the scholarship of any student / all of them at any time at its sole discretion and University have no right to bind the Society in any manner.
7. Scholarship amount shall be transferred to the University designated account directly.
8. Scholarship shall be awarded to the student in successive years until graduation provided the recipient maintains eligibility.
9. Document proving eligibility / continuation should be attached with the application.
